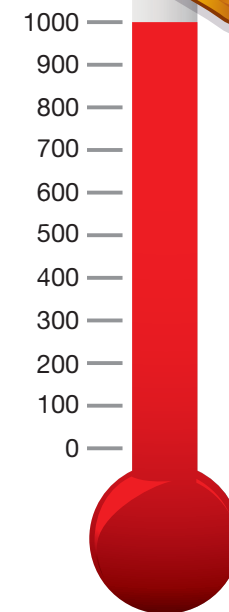
Grace: The Remedy for Sin....continued
